You will be met by our festival assistants.

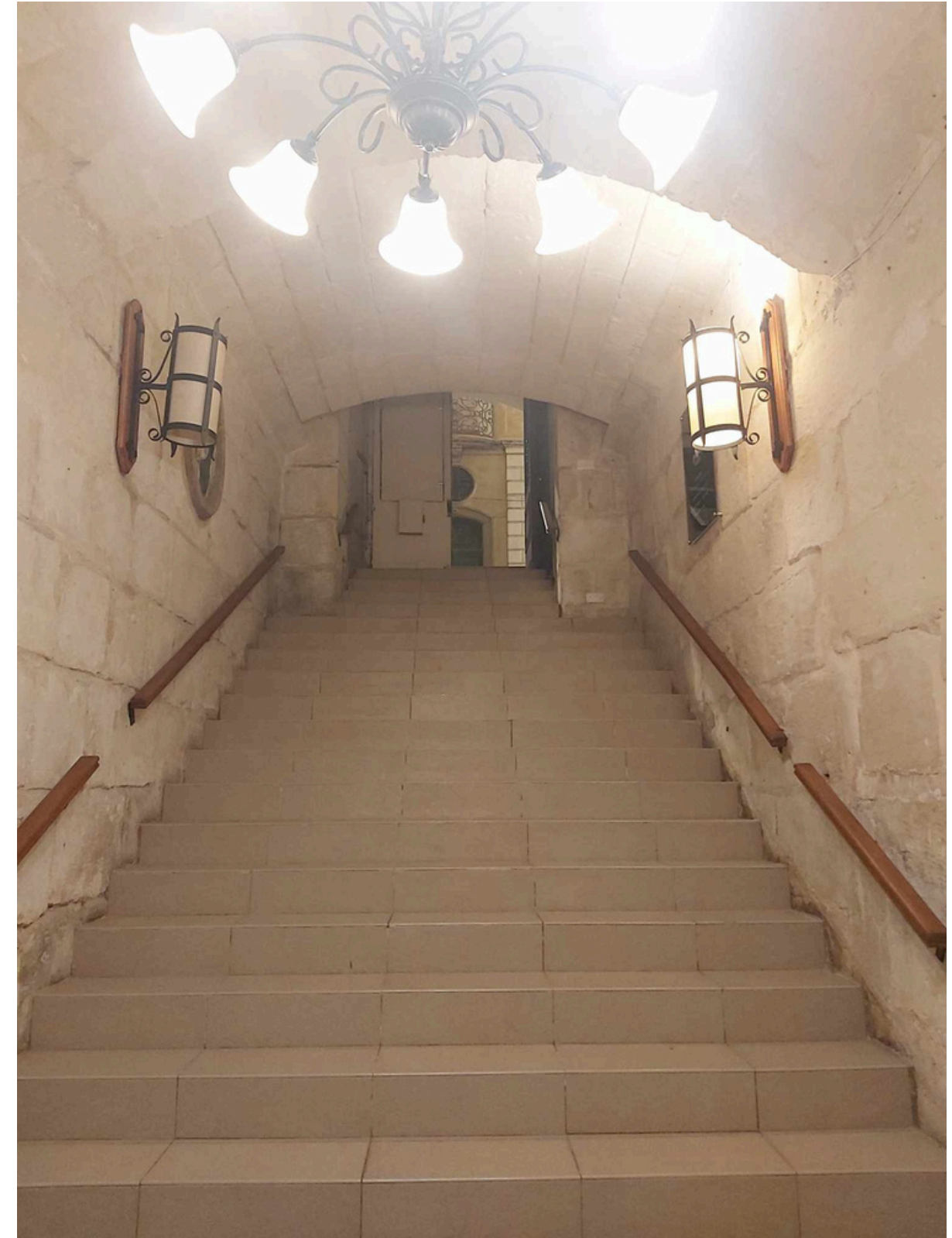
Our assistants will be wearing a T-shirt like this picture and are there to help you.

They will guide you to the theatre and scan your tickets.

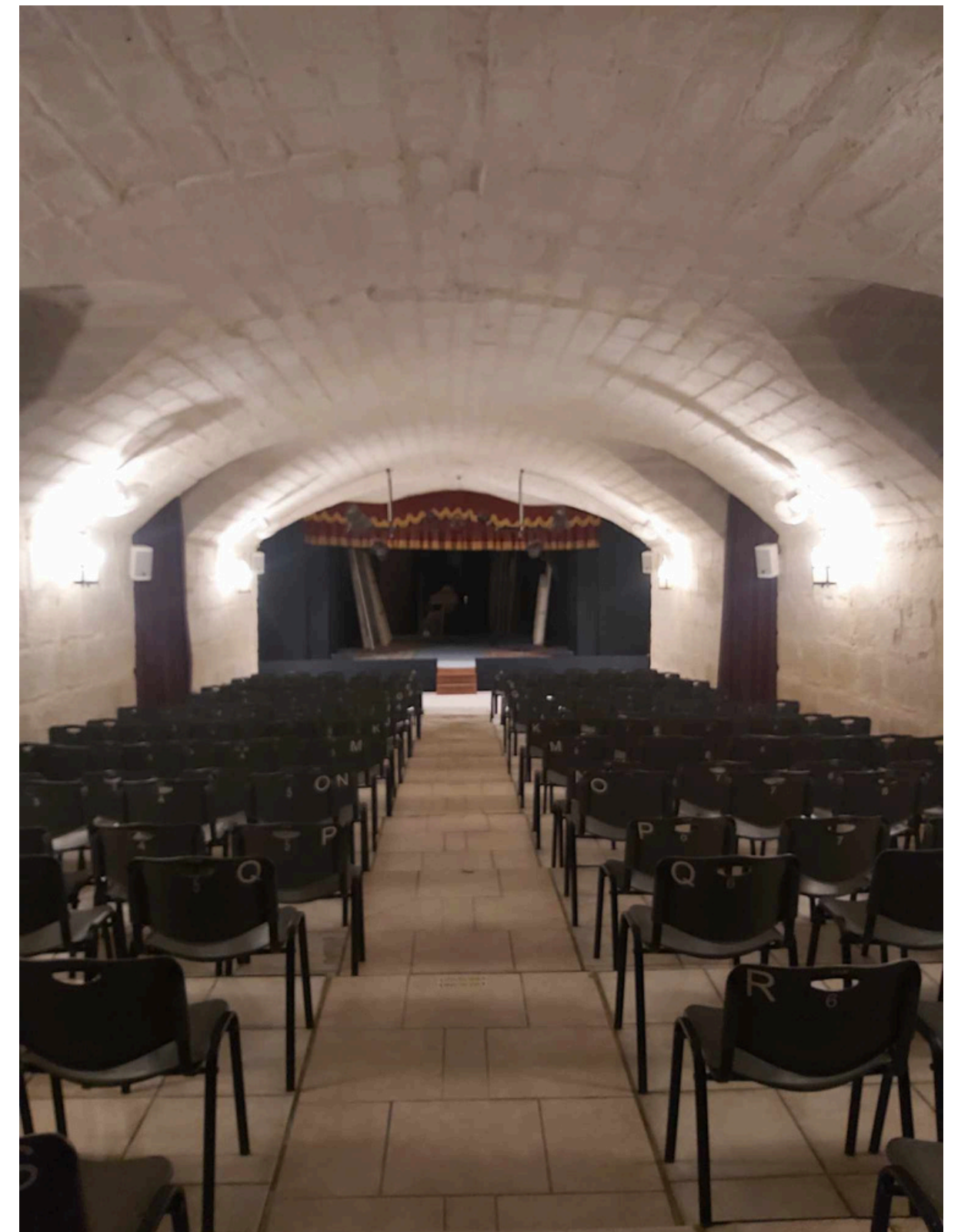


When you enter the venue, you will be in the main hallway area. The show will take place inside the theatre.

Once it is time to start, the assistants will open the doors to the theatre so you can take your seats.



This is what it looks inside in the theatre. It might be a bit dark but not too dark.



There will be an area up the stairs for you if you need a break during the performance. It will have comfortable chairs and a sofa.

You can come back into the show when you're ready.

If you need to use the restrooms, they are near the bar through the hallway on the right of the stage.

You will find a restroom sign next to the door. It is both men and women's.

What will happen during the show:

You will hear an announcement that the show is about to begin.

This is the start of the show!

If you find something funny, you can laugh! If you see or hear something that makes you sad, that's okay too!

You might hear other people laughing, clapping, and shouting.

What will happen at the end of the show:

At the end of the show the actors will come out and take a bow.

You can clap if you want to.

The actors will exit the stage. This is the end of the show.

You can now leave the theatre by taking the same route as when you entered.
